

AAB Membership and Remit

Welcome to the section of the website where you can find out more about the academy's AAB and the work that we do.

The academy has an Academy Advisory Body made up of members of the community, parents and staff. There are currently 7 members in total.

The Academy Advisory Body is responsible for the financial and strategic management of the academy and they meet several times throughout the academic year. We are also joined by Members of the DELTA Human Resources and Finance Teams throughout the year.

The Academy AAB Vice Chair is Sally Cieslik.

The main remit of the AAB is to support the Senior Leadership Team and all the staff – the phrase often used to describe this role is 'a critical friend'. We help leaders to set and reach targets and to strive for excellence across the whole spectrum of academy life. The two key documents used for this are the Academy Development Plan (ADP) and the Self Evaluation Form (SEF). The ADP sets out a three year strategic plan for the school, with targets that everyone works towards and the SEF sets out how well the academy is doing and where we aim to make improvements.

Our legal duties include:-

- **setting strategic direction, policies and objectives**
- **approving the academy budget**
- **reviewing progress against the academy's budget and objectives**
- **appointing, challenging and supporting the Senior Leadership Team**

There are several categories of AAB member appointed by different groups that have an interest in the academy. These include Parent, Staff and DELTA. All AAB members have equal status.

Our main Academy Advisory Body meetings are held after school or in the evenings. Some of the committee meetings may be held during school time. We attend training sessions and complete online training to help us keep up to date with changes in Academies and education to enable us do our job effectively. We also go into the academy to meet with the Head of Academy, other members of staff and pupils to help us find out how the academy is progressing towards its targets.
